It is requested, where possible, that each dojo belonging to the Kyokushin GB organisation provides at least two officials (referee, judge or table official). Each squad entered should have a 'Squad Captain', who may be any adult associated with their club, to assist in ensuring that the clubs fighters are ready to go onto the mat to fight when required and support them when they fight from the mat. This should ensure a safe, enjoyable, smoothly run competition and prevent possible delays waiting for students to put on the appropriate equipment.

A Referee & Judge technical seminar will be held prior to the event any officials wishing to participate in the tournament must attend this event, further detailed information on this session to follow.

WOMEN'S WEIGHT DIVISIONS – numbers permitting

- Category 1: Lightweight, Under 55 Kg
- Category 2: Middleweight: 55kg – under 65kg
- Category 3: Heavyweight, Over 65 Kg

MEN'S WEIGHT DIVISIONS– numbers permitting

- Category 1 Lightweight: Under 70 Kg
- Category 2 Middleweight: 70 Kg - under 80 Kg
- Category 3 Heavyweight: Over 80 Kg

If, at the weigh in, any fighter fails to make the weight division they have been entered in - it will be at the discretion of the Tournament Organisers if the fighter will be required to fight in the appropriate weight category or be **disqualified** from fighting on the day. It is recommended that competitors obtain personal accident insurance cover for the tournament.

Novice category will follow same weight divisions. Competitors are permitted two Novice competitions before they are no longer considered Novice.
